The **APAAR ID** (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry) is an upgraded, lifelong academic identity introduced by the Government of India. It's part of the *One Nation, One Student ID* initiative and helps store all your certificates, achievements, and credits in a single place.

## Steps to Create APAAR ID via DigiLocker

## 1. Sign Up on DigiLocker

- Register with your mobile number or Aadhaar.
- Set your security PIN.

#### 2. Find APAAR ID Section

o In the search bar, type "APAAR" or "ABC ID Card" and click the result.

## 3. Enter Required Info

- Fill in your student details (UDISE+ ID, school name, DOB, etc.).
- Tick the box to allow Aadhaar linking.

## 4. Submit and Download

- o Submit the form to auto-generate your APAAR ID.
- You can access it under "Issued Documents" and download it as a PDF.
